#### **End of Year Giving Statements**

Once again, to save paper and postage, the church will not be doing widespread printing up and distributing annual giving statements. Everyone can now easily generate their own statements from their Realm account whenever they like. **If you do require a hard copy done the traditional way, please just let the office know and we can provide one.** If you haven't accessed Realm and need a new invite sent, just let the office know. You can also see all your current giving and history all the way back to 2008. Below are easy step by step instructions to print your giving statements.

### **Accessing Giving Record & End of Year Giving Statements**

To generate and print out giving statements from your Realm account-

- Log into Realm
- Click on "Giving" on the left side of the page. It will automatically show your gifts for *this* year, to date, to verify your gifts.
- For Yearly Statements, click the Filter button (that droopy triangle symbol) and change the Gift Date Range to "Last Year". then click the blue "Filter" button.
- To print, simply click the Printer Icon. A report will generate, and you can click the Printer Icon in that window to print your statement.

# This week we have some exciting news from our former Pastor Bob Paulen

Dear Friends.

As a former pastor at your church, I thought some folks might be interested in this piece of news about one of my activities in retirement. The USA Track and Field Awards Committee has selected me as the 2022 Age Group - M 85-89 Athlete of the Year for America. This award was based on a review of athlete performances for the year. I won all 5 events I entered at the National Indoor Championship, all six events entered at the National Outdoor Championship, and broke three American records. The records were set in the short hurdlers, both indoors and outdoors, and the long hurdles which is only contested outdoors. The other events that I won at each championship were the long jump, triple jump, high jump and pentathlon. (The indoor pentathlon consists of the long jump, 200 meters, 1,500 meters, discus and javelin. The outdoor events are the high jump, long jump, short hurdles, shotput and 1,000 meters.)

I shall be going to Poland in March to represent the USA at the World Masters Athletic Championships. Hopefully I'll be well conditioned and represent our country with a top effort.
